Everyone gets the same—regardless if it's needed or right for them.

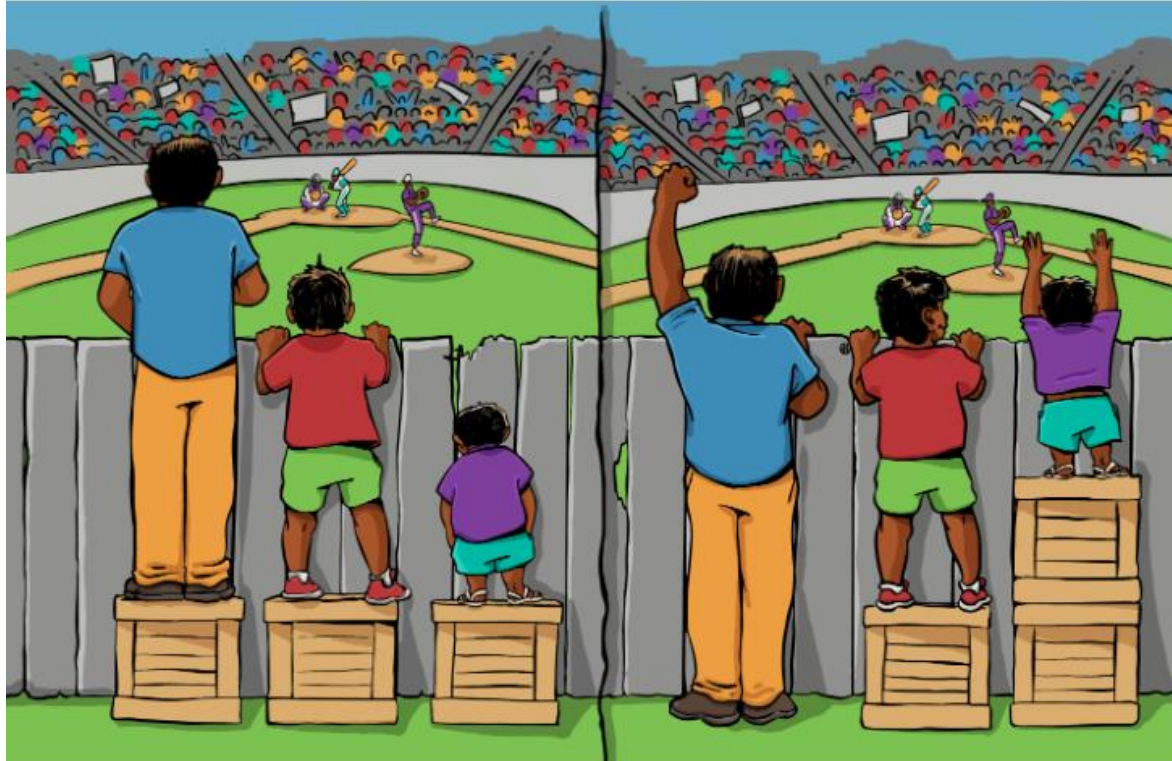


## EQUITY:
