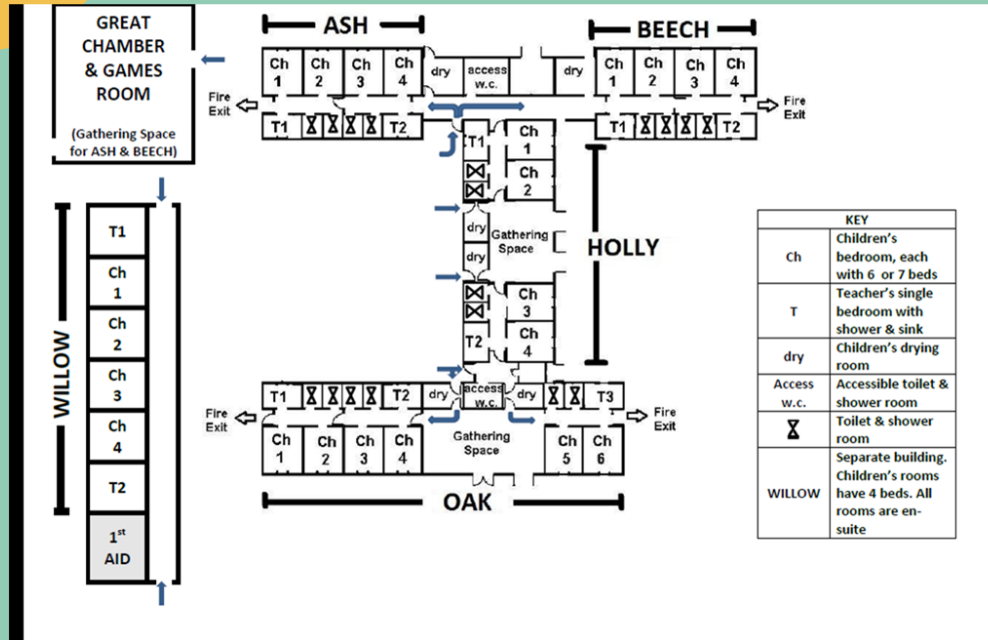
# Who is going on the visit?

- 33 children from Year 4
  - The children will be accompanied by 3 members of Joseph Hood staff (This is a mix of male and female). Mr Fallon, Miss Fullalove, Mrs Wright / Mrs Saville
  - Stubbington also have resident staff including a welfare assistant, who are available should the need arise. These staff also support with the teaching of activities during the day.
  - There is 24hr night Stubbington staff member on duty throughout the evening to support with any issues that may occur.
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# Stubbington

- The centre can accommodate up to 112 children – with other schools: **we eat and complete house challenges / evening games with the other schools**
  - Each school is allocated their own accommodation block(s)
  - Children are accommodated in single gender rooms of up to 6 beds – teachers allocate rooms prior to the visit but children will find out when they arrive. **We ensure that the children are in a room with some of their friends**
  - Teacher's rooms are in the same block as the children's and are opposite their rooms
  - Each school is allocated their own a central 'break out space' which acts as social space;
  - Accommodation blocks are code entry – no entry from the outside at night.
  - Showers and bathrooms are situated within the blocks opposite the dormitories

# Medical Information

- Please ensure you have identified any medical issues or medications needed as these need to be logged before the visit commences including travel sickness medication.
  - Any agreed medications (on the medical form) need to be checked and brought into the school of Friday 3rd July between 08:30 am and 09:00. Please do not give medications to the school office as these have to be logged.
  - You will need to completed an updated form if any medical issues change between now and when the visit commences
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# Ticks

As there may be deer on site, ticks can be a risk to be aware of. Stubbington Study Centre will alert children who are resident at the centre to this risk and have control measures in place. Such as:



- Maintaining pathways where grass is kept shorter.
- Ensuring visitors wear long trousers when working around trees or long grass (e.g. in our Conservation Area)
- Warning visitors to keep to paths and avoid walking through bushes & long grass.
- Encouraging children to check for ticks and inform an adult if they think they have picked one up.
- Having staff available who are equipped and experienced in removing ticks.
- Issuing letters for schools to give to parents alerting them to the issue, when ticks are found on site.

# Thursday 2nd July 08:45 am...

- Any agreed medications need to be checked and brought into the school hall on Friday 3rd July between 08:30 am and 09:00. Please do not give medications to the school office as these have to be logged with the staff attending the visit.
  - Please bring in the spending money for your child. This can be up to £12.00 only. Please ensure that this is in a names envelope or purse and the school staff will keep a hold of this. If this could be in £1.00 coins this would be really helpful.
  - Please bring in any souvenir order forms with the money that you have not given to the school office so that these can be filed by the staff attending the visit and taken to Stubbington.

# Monday 6th July from 08:15 am...

- Bring your child, with their bag / holdall by 08:15 am (please label), into the hall and sign in with the member of staff taking the register
  - Give any travel sickness tablets for the journey before leaving for school. Sickness tablets for the journey back should be dropped off on Friday 14th June with medications and spending money
  - Please wait with your child and wave them off. **The coach will depart at 08:30 am sharp**
  - School will parentmail when we arrive at Stubbington.
- Please make sure that your child has a filled water bottle for the journey. They will not need any food with them as this is all provided at the centre.**
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# Catering

- All the children eat together in the centre's dining room which is called the Snuffle hole
  - Children catered for three meals a day plus snacks throughout the day as well as supper just before bed time
  - There is a good choice at meal times including a cooked breakfast.
  - Different dietary needs can be catered for – *provide these details on the medical form as this is what is communicated to the Stubbington Study Centre prior to the visit.*

# Communication

Please don't use this platform to ask specific questions about your children. If there are any issues, we will contact you directly.

**Remember, you child should not bring a mobile phone and they will not be calling you throughout the week.**

## FAQs:

### **Can I call and speak to my child / can my child call and speak to me whilst they are away?**

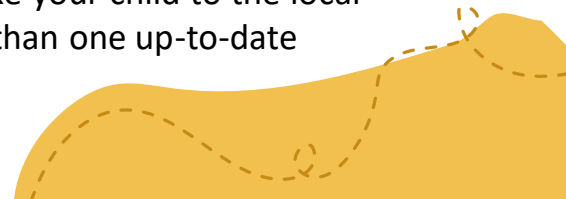
Unfortunately, this will not happen. Staff will comfort any children who are feeling a little homesick. This does not happen very much as children are so busy all day long.

### **What happens if my child gets sick / wets the bed / gets hurt?**

School staff will be in rooms near the children's dorm rooms. Staff names are pinned on the doors. Staff are discrete when sorting these issues out. There is spare bedding. Please let us know well in advance if your child may need support at nighttime with bedwetting.

### **Will school staff call me?**



School staff will only call you if they need to give you information, such as; if your child has been unwell, has been hurt and has needed medical attention by the first aid staff onsite (this will not happen for minor scrapes and cuts), if we need to take your child to the local minor injury clinic, etc. This is why it is crucial that you put more than one up-to-date telephone number that you can be contacted on.





# Return:

## On Friday 10th July:

- The coach is due to return by the end of the day usually around 2.30 - 3.00pm. We will Parent-mail to inform you of an early / late return
  - Children should be taken home as soon as they arrive back to school – they will be dismissed to you.
  - No child will be allowed to walk home on their own
  - **Collect all medicines before leaving unless they are kept in school**
  - **After School Club is not an option for the children who have been on a residential on the day of return.**
